

## Ticket Validity

Starting from **March 31, 2020**, we made two important changes for tickets issued with **LATAM GROUP**:

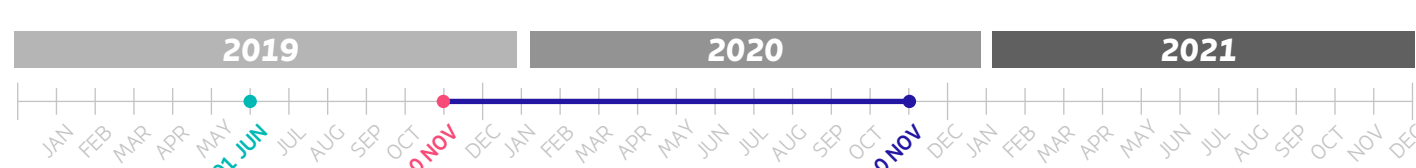
- 1- All tickets, regardless of the date of issue, are valid **12 months** from the first departure segment date of the ticket.
- 2- Tickets with the first flight between: **March 2020** and **December 2020** can be rebooked until **December 31, 21**.

Examples:

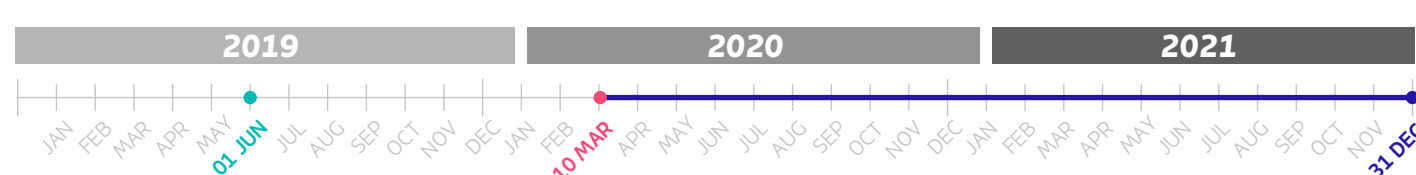


**For tickets issued in 2019 to fly in 2019 and 2020**

- 1- Issued: **June 1, 2019**  
First flight: **10 Nov 2019**  
Validity: **10 Nov 2020**

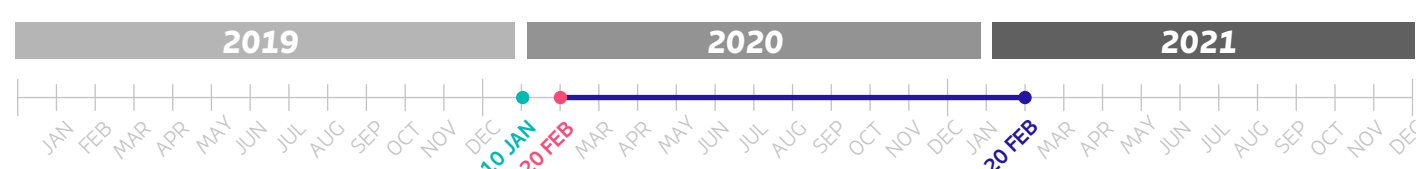


- 2- Issued: **June 1, 2019**  
First flight: **March 10, 2020**  
Validity: **December 31, 2021**



**For tickets issued in 2020 to fly in 2020 (From January to February and from March to December)**

- 1- Issued: **January 10, 2020**  
First flight: **February 20, 2020**  
Validity: **February 20, 2021**

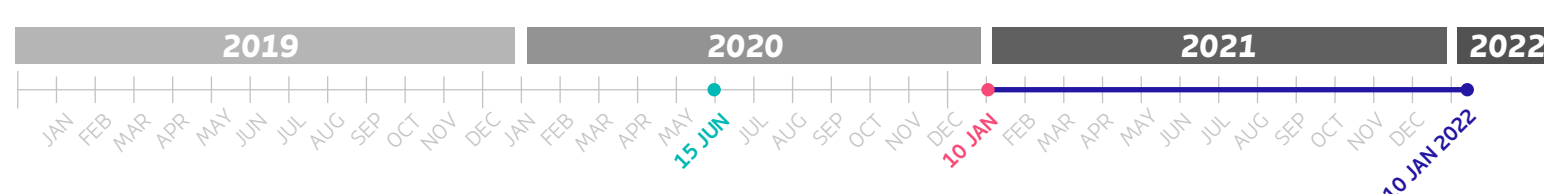


- 2- Issued: **March 1, 2020**  
First flight: **October 10, 2020**  
Validity: **December 31, 2021**



**Scenario tickets issued in 2020 to fly in 2021**

- 1- Issued: **June 15, 2020**  
First flight: **January 10, 2021**  
Validity: **January 10, 2022**



### Important:

- Tickets partially used have the same validity: 12 months from the first departure date
- When reissuing the tickets, the new travel dates can be after the date of validity, as long as the flights are available in the GDS, and that the reissue is made while the ticket is still valid.
- The ticket validity extension is for tickets departing from March 1st 2020 - December 31st 2020, and is only for exchange (not refunds)
- The Ticket Validity for refunds will be 12 months from the date of the first segment
- The ticket validity is 12 months from the date of the first ticket coupon, this replaces the issuance date.
