

How far in advance does the passenger need to be at the airport for the trip?

Below you can check how much in advance the passenger should arrive at the airport to avoid issues on the trip. During high season, plan to arrive early at the boarding gate, as the border and security control procedures tend to result in longer waiting times.

Exceptions in arrival time recommendations:

***Flights from Easter Island (IPC): Check-in 4 hours before departure.**

***Flights to Galapagos Islands: show up 2 hours and 30 minutes prior to the flight departure time.**
